The Hominy Masonic Lodge is located at 50 Old Pisgah Highway in Candler.

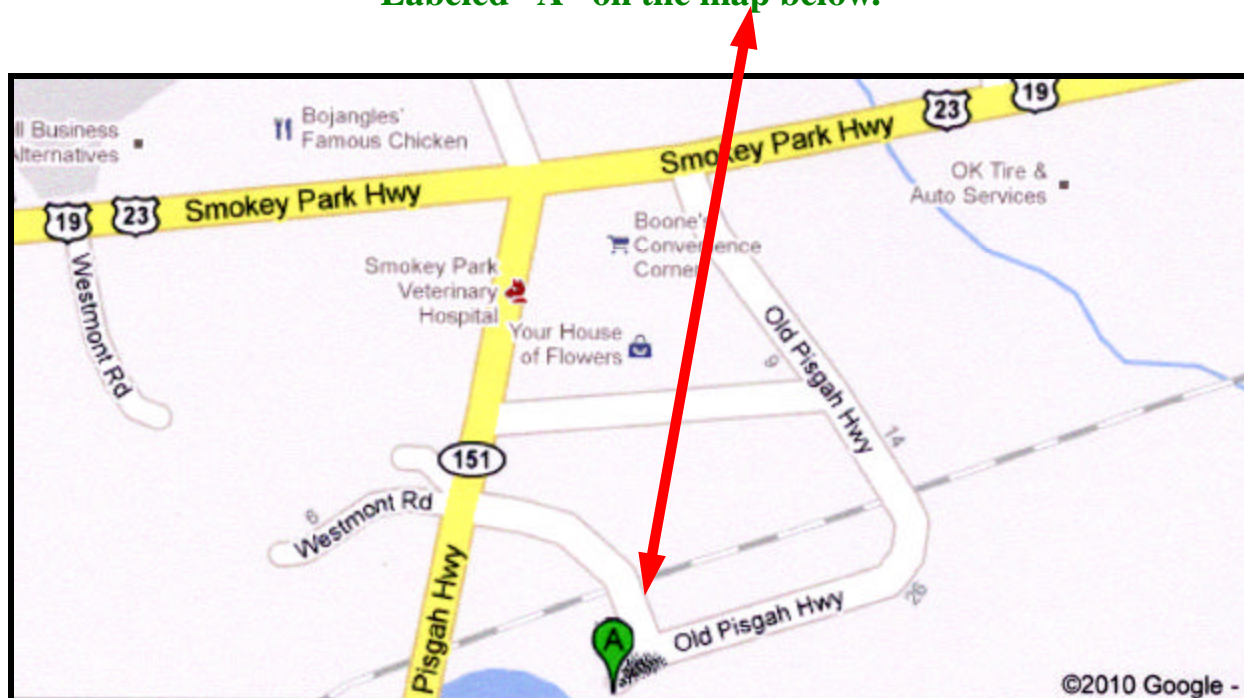
Take 19-23 to Candler.
